RoHS Declaration of Conformity

(in accordance with Directive 2011/65/EU)

Dear customer,

We hereby confirm that our products comply with the requirements of the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU (including RoHS II/III). These directives concern the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

These are listed below and must not exceed the respective limit value.

- Lead (Pb) (0.1%)
- Mercury (Hg) (0.1%)
- Cadmium (Cd) (0.01%)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr VI) (0.1%)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1%)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1%)
- Di(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1%)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1%)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1%)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1%)

The conformity is based on:

- supplier declarations / material data (e.g. IMDS, material certificates)
- internal assessments in accordance with our material compliance processes

For certain applications, however, the EU permits time-limited exemptions when no suitable technical alternative is yet available.

In the present case, these exemptions concern the use of lead as an alloying element in specific metals:

- **Exemption 6(b):** Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2018/740 of 1 March 2018 amending Annex III to Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council regarding an exemption for lead as an alloying element in aluminium (up to 0.4%).
- **Exemption 6(c):** Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2018/741 of 1 March 2018 amending Annex III to Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council regarding an exemption for lead as an alloying element in copper (up to 4%).

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In accordance with the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU, we inform you that brass components and certain aluminum alloys contain the substance lead in concentrations above 0.1%. We confirm that all applicable exemptions are properly documented and applied within their valid transition periods.

Ongoing updates regarding the status of exemptions are monitored in line with publications from the EU Commission (e.g., "Exemptions list – validity and rolling plan").
